An Engineering Link Project follows the design - make - appraise model of problem solving, so each group will fully prepare their solution on paper, present it to the engineer for approval and then have the opportunity to construct their solution. Each group's solution will be tested to ensure it meets the criteria set, then extended beyond the scope of the design, usually to destruction!
